Managing Study Team Changes (Co-Investigators)

New Co-Investigator (Co-I) Dr Charles



The Principal Investigator (PI) was notified that Co-Investigator Dr Bruce will be leaving the study team. Dr Charles will be added as a new Co-Investigator to take over Dr Bruce's responsibilities.







Ensure compliance with requirements to prevent non-compliance

New Co-Investigators must have IRB approval, meet qualifications, and complete mandatory training before commencing their research duties

Before Dr Charles take over Dr Bruce's responsibilities and be Co-I;





- Has Dr Charles met the relevant qualification and minimum training requirements set by the reviewing IRB and/or Research Institution? (where applicable)
- Have Dr Charles's minimum training certificate/reports been validated and minimum training labels applied? For more information, refer here.
- Has Dr Charles received adequate protocol training on all delegated tasks by the PI?

Notify Key Stakeholders

- Has a study amendment been submitted to the IRB to add Dr Charles and remove Dr Bruce?
- Are sponsors notified? (If applicable)

Ensure Proper Documentation



- Is a copy of Dr Charles's latest CV and completed minimum training certificate/reports maintained in the Investigator File?
- Is the study delegation log updated to end Dr Bruce's participation and to start Dr Charles participation in the study?
- Has Dr Charles's protocol training been documented and maintained in the Investigator File?
